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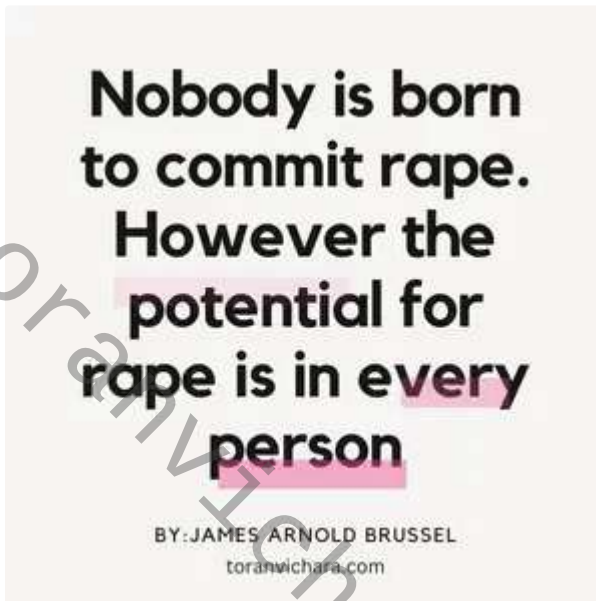
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"Aren't we all terrorists without a gun?"

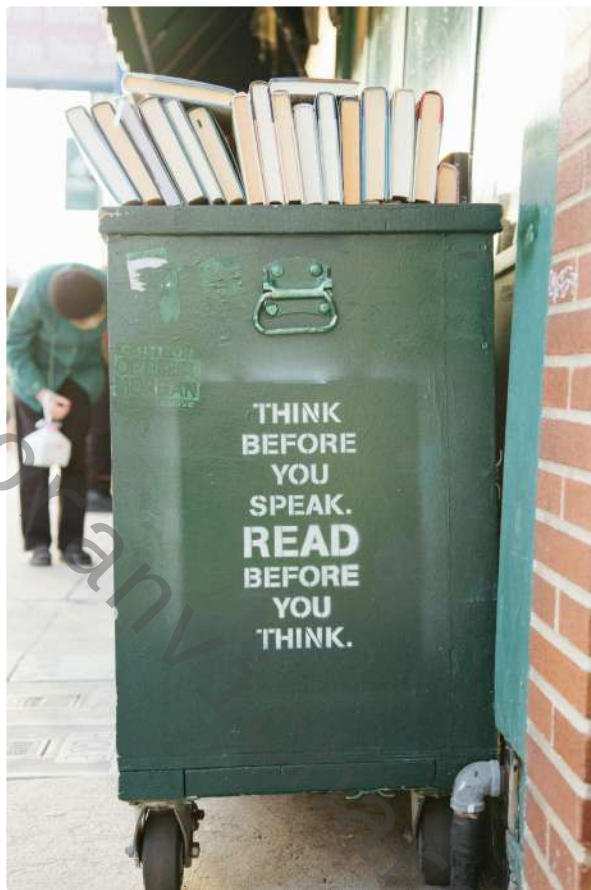
"Terriost is a man who can't let go. A person who
