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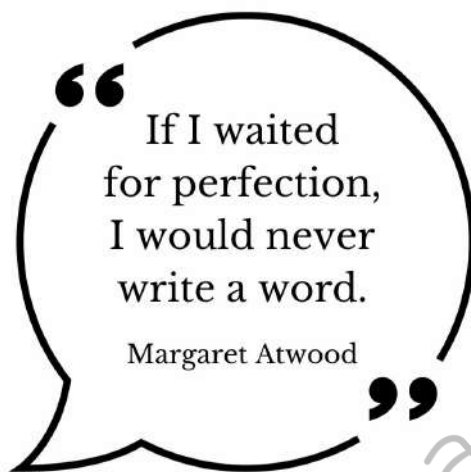
Hypocrisy, as stated by its definition, refers to the
