To quote it as it is quoted officially is:

"Mission: *life* is a six-episode video series, divided into three categories: Voices, Case Study, and Events. Created by a group of high school students directly after their final exams, it is an act of rebellion against the societal pressure of 'figuring out life' in Nepali society immediately after graduation, a severe contrast to being 'spoon-fed' your path your whole life. Through this series, we explore critical social issues, share diverse perspectives, and

highlight real stories from our community. It's our way of using our voices to spark conversations, inspire change, and remind everyone (and us) that life needs to be lived."

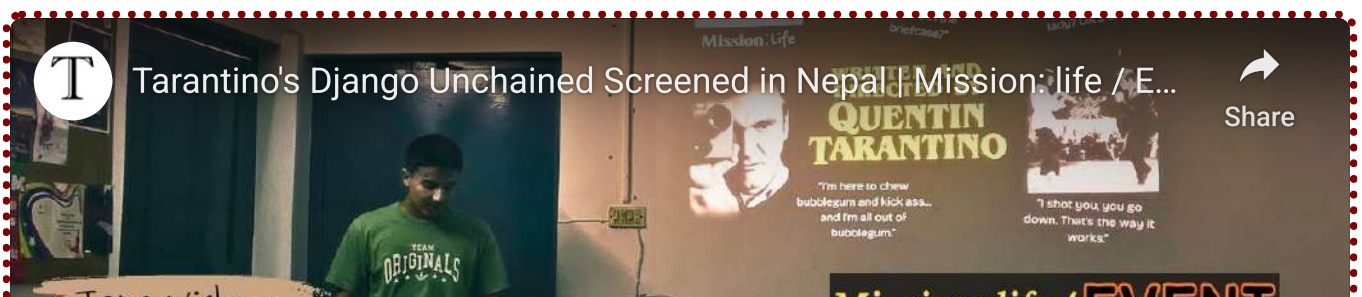
Mental Health: Status, Cure & Stigma in Nepal (w/ Hashana Shrestha) | Mission: life / Case Studies |

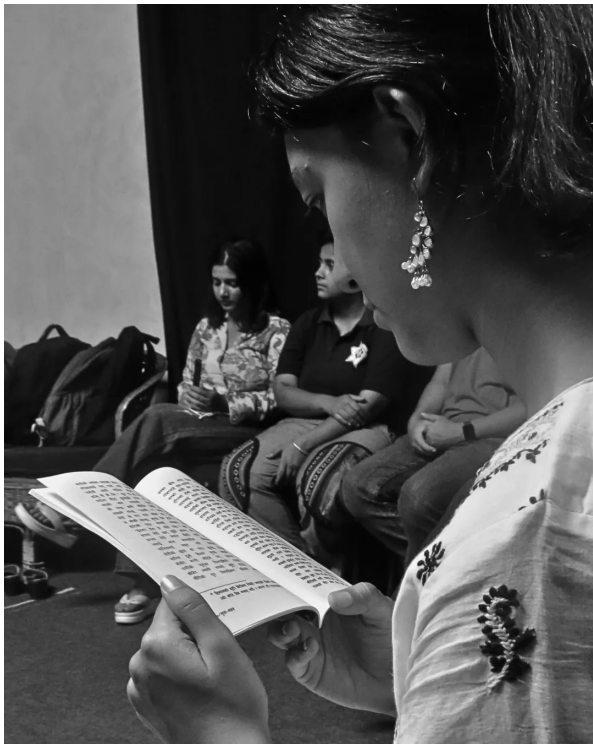
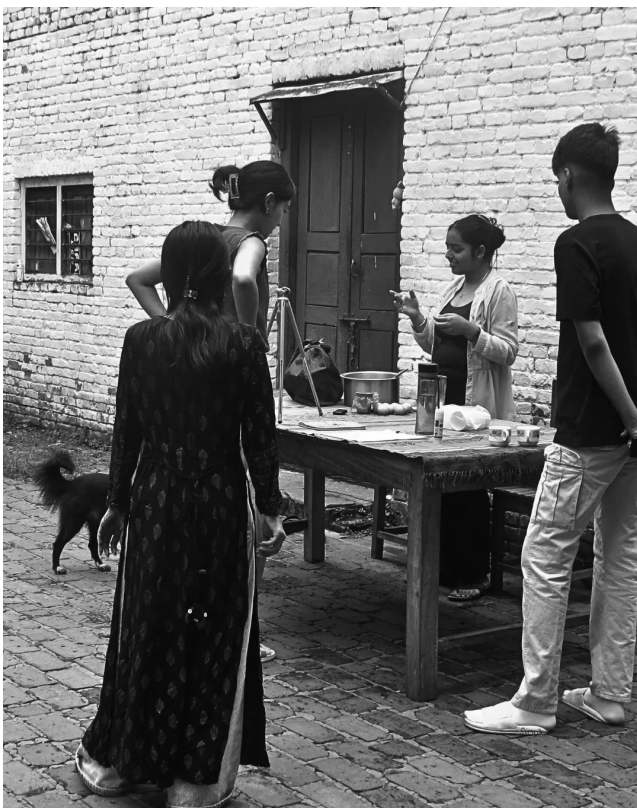
